**Church History II (3 Credits):**

This class is an awesome account and study of the developments of the Church during the years 410 A.D. to 1500 A.D. We will study: the Eastern and Western Church; the Crusades and the rise of Islam; important church leaders and the struggle between the church and the state. This will set the stage for the coming Reformation.

**The Book of Acts Part 1 Chapters 1-14 (3 Credits):**

You will be blessed in this class as we study the history of the work of the Holy Spirit in the development of the early New Testament Church, from the Ascension of Christ to Paul's imprisonment at Rome and the beginning of his ministry there. Acts covers a period of 30 years of the beginnings of the New Testament Church. The Book of Acts confirms the Great Commission and gives us a bridge between the Gospels and the Epistles which helps us to better serve the Lord in the Ministry.

**Old Testament Introduction I (3 Credits):**

This study includes a general introduction to all the Books of the Old Testament, with a brief analysis of each book, with careful consideration of selected passages from Genesis through Esther regarding the Lord.
